Art has been an important part of Bob Lizza's life for as long as he could remember. His natural love of drawing as a youngster evoked a persistent determination and personal challenge to succeed as an artist. His study of fine art coupled with marketing at College Misericordia would prove to be a perfect mix in his evolutionary quest to meld fine art with technology. His early areas of specialty were in oil painting and rendering using both graphite and pen and ink. Departing college, many local, state and federal agencies began commissioning Bob to paint a collection of architectural landmarks in Northeastern Pennsylvania.

Bob and his wife, Pam moved to Tunkhannock in 1987. He subsequently established Lizza Studios, a high-tech fine art hub also located in Tunkhannock, Pennsylvania.

Bob's inspirations as a painter today come from effects of illuminations created in nature. In his painting, he strives for extreme vivid colors and harsh shadows in his subjects derived from the unique and brief nature of light created during dawn or dusk.
